The Holy Rosary (October 7)

Tomorrow, the church celebrates the memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. As a parish, we honor her in our weekly rosary prayed before Sunday Mass. On so many of our homes, barns and in our windows, we praise her with a beautiful lighted rosary. Now, a large painting of her under this title, graces the wall in our restored church and bonds us with our Cathedral, Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary. St. Dominic is credited with being presented with a rosary by Our Lady when she appeared to him in 1214. He spread devotion to her throughout his life, as did the order he founded, the Dominicans. At that time, the church was fighting heresies. Pope Pius XII said that "the origin of the rosary is more divine than human in its origin and wisdom." Again, between February 11 and July 16 in 1858, Our Lady appeared 18 times to St. Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes. Every time, she was seen holding a rosary in her hands! In 1917 at Fatima, Mary appeared to 3 shepherd children and asked them to recite the rosary frequently for peace in the world. She taught them (and us) how to meditate on the mysteries and pray "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins" at the end of each decade. On October 13, 1917, the last Fatima appearance, Mary said she wanted to be called "Our Lady of the Rosary." It is this image that appears in church. Praying the rosary through the centuries has produced marvelous results: heresies uprooted, morals reformed, tragedies averted, wars ended. What a treasure we have in this powerful prayer!


