## Message from Father Jeff

I hope you're enjoying your last days before Lent and that you've taken some time to make a spiritual game plan for the coming Holy Season. I wanted to give you a bit of an update on what's going on with my recovery. I met with the PA in my surgeon's office last week. My wound is healing well and I am making some progress in leg control. My brace is still locked in the extended position and will be for the next 4-6 weeks, so that still presents some challenges.

Since that appointment, I've been practicing on stairs and working on gaining some independence. Right now, the plan is that I'll take up residence again in the Delphos rectory on Ash Wednesday. I will start Physical Therapy 2-3 times a week as soon as they can get me scheduled. I am still under orders to keep my leg elevated and iced more often than not and I am easily physically tired, so I will not be resuming a normal work schedule. While it's my intention to make myself available by email and phone. I won't be out and about every day nor am I able to sit in a chair easily and certainly not at a desk.

I'm really only at the beginning of my recovery. If I am lucky, I might be able to drive by the end of April. I will have the brace on my leg until June, and will not be considered "healed" and "free to resume all activities" until mid-August. I thank you for the patience and grace that you've shown in the last month since my fall. I truly appreciate all of your kind words, cards, flowers, and prayers. This was a temporary solution until a new convent could be built. Plans to turn the rectory into a convent and build a new rectory were underway when the church was destroyed by the tornado and had to be postponed.
