Use of Corporal at Holy Mass

You may have noticed that we are using an added linen cloth (called a 'corporal') at Holy Mass. The corporal, a white cloth of about 22 in. square is placed on top of the altar cloth but beneath the chalice and paten. At the beginning of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the priest unfolds the corporal in the center of the altar and places the sacred vessels upon it. Its purpose is to collect any fragments from the Eucharistic Body of Christ during the Mass. It is folded into nine squares, with a red embroidered cross at the center bottom square. We are most grateful to Martha Miller for sewing our new corporals and to Jann Bonifas for applying the small red cross on each. The word "corporal" come from the Latin which means "Body." It is so named because of its relationship with the Eucharistic Body of Christ.
