This Week in Parish History

After St. John the Baptist in Landeck was destroyed by the tornado, a new church was designed by Thomas D. McLaughlin & Keil (architects) of Lima. Thomas D. McLaughlin had designed the Deisel-Wemmer Cigar



Factory building in Delphos (across from St. John's church) in 1910, Delphos Jefferson High School in 1912, the Delphos Carnegie Public Library in 1912, Cleveland's Notre Dame College's Chapel in 1927 (which is similar to Landeck's church), and Delphos St. Johns Rectory in 1938. He also designed two houses in Delphos - the Clarence Leilich residence at 511 E. 5th St, and the C. B. Hunt residence at 431 W. 3rd St.
