

Blessing of Throats

TOMORROW Monday, February 3, the feast of St. Blaise, a 4th century Bishop and Martyr, there will be an individual blessing of throats at the 8:00 a.m. Mass at Delphos St. John the Evangelist and the 7:00 p.m. Mass at Landeck St. John the Baptist Churches. This longstanding tradition has its roots in the life of St. Blaise who, on his way to martyrdom, miraculously cured a young boy who was choking on a fish bone. The blessing asks that the recipient be delivered from any illness of the throat and every other illness. It will take place after the General Intercessions.

Consecrated Life: What Really Is It?

Consecrated life is a gift to the Church. It is a call from God to a particular way of following Him. A call to belong completely to Christ and to live as He did - in celibacy, obedience and poverty. A call to live a rule (way of life) written by holy men and women with a particular spirituality-ex. Franciscan, Precious Blood, Jesuit, Notre Dame, Mercy, Redemptorist, Dominican. Those in consecrated life respond to this call through the vows, lived in community, for the sake of a mission entrusted to them by the Church. They live for God. God is the primary focus and center of all they are and do! Like Christ, they give themselves in service to others in many different ministries, ex: education, healthcare, retreat work, contemplative life, service to the poor. Our two Sisters here, the Sisters of Christian Charity, follow the charism of Blessed Pauline von Mallinckrodt. It is one of joy, energy and enthusiasm in works of charity, flowing from intimacy with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. We live a God- centered life in active service to others. "My hands at work, my heart with God." The simple, gold 'wedding band' on our finger expresses the reality that we are His. Completely. And therefore, sent to share His Love and Life with the world.
