### Dear Friends,

What a wonderful weekend to welcome Bishop Walsh back to our parishes in Delphos, Landeck, and Spencerville! Special thanks to all of the volunteers who made our liturgies beautiful last weekend and to all those who worked to make the reception at the Knights of Columbus hall a success. At his ordination Mass, Bishop Walsh mentioned that the most influential practice for his faith was instilled by his parents-to attend Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation without fail. We're going to have a special opportunity for grace coming up in just a few weeks...

December 7-9 is going to prove to be a busy few days! Bishop Thomas will be here that weekend to install me as pastor of all three parishes. I warmly invite you to join the Bishop and I for Holy Mass on Saturday, December 7 at 4:30pm in Delphos, Sunday, December 8 at 8:30am in Landeck, and Sunday, December 8 at 10:30am in Spencerville.

Monday, December 9 is a Holy Day of Obligation. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is normally celebrated on December 8, but because that falls on a Sunday of Advent this year, the Solemnity–and the obligation to attend Holy Mass–is transferred to Monday, December 9 this year. Since there are *two* days of obligation (Sunday of Advent and Monday Holy Day), that means you'll need to plan to attend *two* Masses during that three-day weekend.

Please note that the 4pm Mass on Sunday, December 8 will be in Spanish. This will be our annual celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe, to which the entire parish is invited! Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, ruega por nostoros!

### **Blessed Advent - Happy New Year**

Yes, today we open a new Liturgical Year. The first Sunday of Advent ushers in another Year of Grace for all of us! The Readings are of Cycle C and appear each Sunday in your Hymnal. Take time to read and pray them! We note that the liturgical color is purple, with a 'pink' Sunday on the third one, called "Gaudate" (Rejoice), when the priest's vestment is a rose color. Advent is a season of preparation. We are directed to turn our thoughts to the coming of the Lord—as a Babe at Christmas and as Christ, King of the Universe, at the end of time. And also to open our eyes to His Presence—each and every day of our lives. You will notice an Advent Wreath in Church. Each week another of the four candles is lighted, signifying the passing of time. This wreath symbolizes the prayer, penance and good works which should fill our lives as we open a new Year and resolve to become better and more faithful followers of Christ. May our patience, prayer and extra opportunities for giving throughout these weeks of Advent open us to the fullness of joy in our hearts at Christmas.
