This Week in Parish History...During the clean up after the tornado, a bottle was found in the plasterwork of the old church. In the bottle was an old document which read: Landeck, O. Sept. 18, 1903. "On the 22nd day of June 1903 the lathering - Plastering - Molding and stucco work of this church was begun and completed on the 18th day of September 1903 the contract for said work was awarded to John F. Winter of Wooster O. who did the work and was assisted by A. R. Crumley, Frank Singler, G. A. Sellers and Jesse Singler. The laborers were Frank Kill and Charles Kill. We boarded with Mr. and Mrs. Adam Youngpeter. The elder daughter was the landlady and cook and was a good one too. She was assisted by Miss Emma Youngpeter, her sister, John B. Verment of Massillon O. was the architect and the Rev. Dominic Zinsmayer was the pastor of the church.

This memoranda was placed in a bottle and placed in the center capital of the east side of the church where it is expected to remain until time will bring some change, God only knows what" by Jon. F. Winter.
