This Week in Parish History



This weekend as we welcome Fr. Jeff Walker, we'll take a look at the history of his home town, Custar, Ohio and the parish of St. Louis. St. Louis was formally estalished as a parish by German and French settlers in the rural village Lewisburg, Ohio in

1864. One year later, Lewisburg was renamed Custar after General Custer, the railroad misspelled the name and the signs were already made so the spelling remains incorrect. A small frame church was built in 1864 and later burned. The cornerstone of the current Gothic style church was laid in 1889. The parish has a school, which at one time was served by the Sisters of Notre Dame. ~Written by Jack Bockey
