

After the tornado, on February 16, 1950, Bishop Karl J. Alter solemnly dedicated the new church. He dedicated the main altar in honor of St. John the Baptist. Rt.

Rev. Msgr. R. I. Kinnane, vicar general of the diocese, consecrated one of the side altars in honor of Mary. The third altar was consecrated at a later date. 
