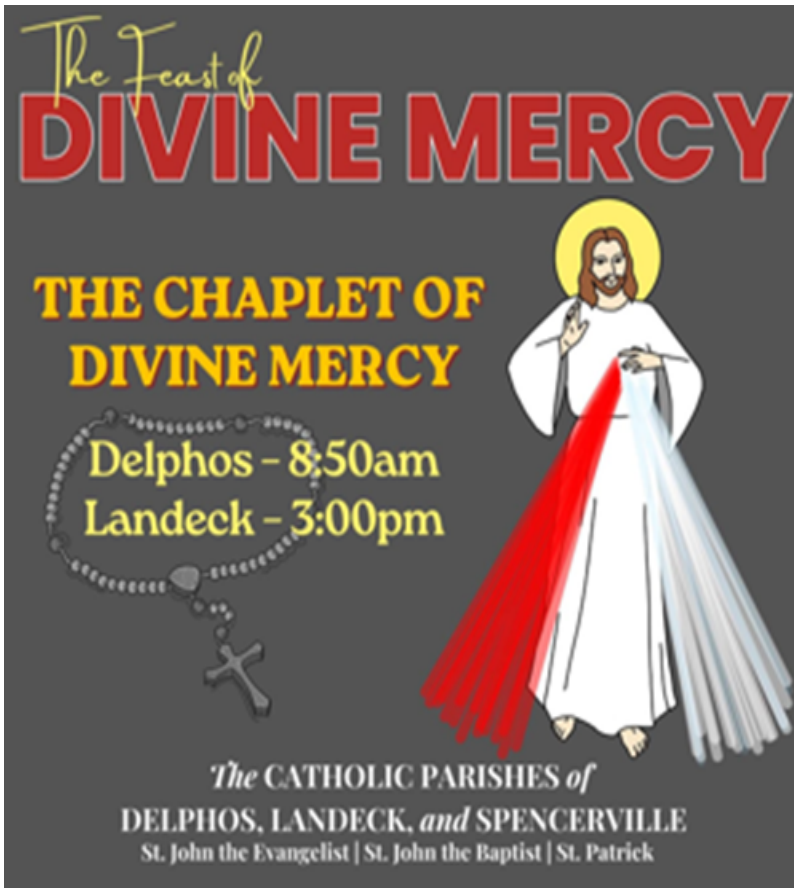

Divine Mercy Sunday Pope St. John Paul II initiated this feast in the year 2000. He wrote “As a gift to humanity, which sometimes feels bewildered and overwhelmed by the power of evil, selfishness and fear, the Risen Lord offer his love that pardons, reconciles and reopens hearts to love. It is a love that converts hearts and gives peace. How much the world needs to understand Divine Mercy!” In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning Divine Mercy that were recorded in her diary. Her diary names 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy be observed. The Chaplet was also given to St. Faustina with this promise:”Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...I desire that the whole world know My Infinite Mercy.” (Diary # 687).
