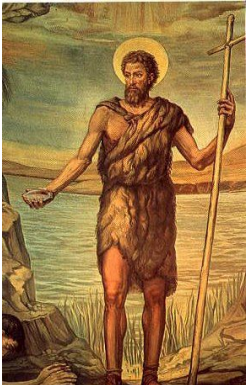
Father's Day Celebrates St. Joseph

He treasured his wife, Mary, and accepted the unfolding of God's will for her. He was prayerful, patiently waiting for God's direction in the life of his family. Let us pray to him today for our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, uncles, cousins and all the men in our lives. Joseph, most faithful, pray for us!
